Who is on my team?

Registration closes on August 12. You will be notified of your child(ren)'s team assignment(s) via **PlayMetrics** no later than **Monday, August 22**.

When is our team practice?

Team practices can begin the week of **Monday, August 29**.

Your practice information will be added to the team PlayMetrics account once the rosters are finalized, and coaches confirm practice days & times.

When are Games?

Games begin **Saturday, September 10**. The schedule will be released by **BAYSA** by September 6. The schedule can also be found on BAYSA.org once it is posted. The initial schedule will be added to team calendars in PlayMetrics, however, all changes will need to be updated by coaches/team managers.

Soccer.com have informed us the uniforms are taking several weeks to ship due to supply chain issues. We encourage you to purchase them asap. These uniforms will be good through the end of the Spring of 2023 season (please note, the recreational uniforms differ from competitive).

What if my uniform doesn't arrive on time?

If your uniform doesn't arrive before the first game, you can wear a shirt in the correct color scheme and use athletic tape for the jersey number until your official jersey arrives.

What other equipment do I need?

Below is what we recommend, other than the uniform:

- Soccer Cleats or Turf Shoes
- Soccer Ball (size chart below)
- Shin Guards
- Large Water Bottle
- Black Shorts
- Long Black Socks (which are worn over the top shin guards)

What size ball do I need?

- **Size 4:** Players born 2012-2011
- **Size 5:** Players born 2010 and older

Volunteers

The Dynamo|Dash Youth Recreational program is a volunteer-based program with each team **requiring at least ONE volunteer coach**, two is preferred.

Requirements

- Conduct 2 weekly team practices at one of the club approved facilities
 - Centennial Park (Friendswood)
 - Chester Davis Sportsplex (League City)
 - Dad's Club Sports Park/Dave Finkel Fields (Clear Lake)
- Coach 1 game per week
- Point of contact for team parents (or have a team manager)
- Complete a background check
